

LOW-INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIHEAP)



We currently have funding for utility assistance. If you live in Holmes, Okaloosa, Santa Rosa, Walton or Washington County, you may be eligible for help with your electric bill. You can apply in person at your local county office, Monday through Thursday from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm, or apply online by scanning the QR Code.

If you haven't received assistance in the last year and you think you may qualify, please apply.

If anyone in your household receives food stamps or SSI, you automatically qualify with the proper documentation. To complete your application, you will need a valid photo ID or driver's license for the applicant, a current (non-expired) Food Stamp letter or SSI award letter, and a copy of your electric bill.

If you do not qualify through Food Stamps or SSI, you will need to provide the following information to determine your eligibility for assistance:

A Current ID or Driver's License for the applicant, Proof of Citizenship for all adults 18 and older (government issued ID or birth certificate), Birth Certificates for all children under 18, Social Security cards or numbers for everyone in the household, your most recent electric bill & proof of all household income.

If you live in HUD or Subsidized Housing (such as section 8), you must also provide your lease or a document that shows your rent amount and whether you receive a utility allowance.
